

Little Flock Preschool Frequently Asked Questions 2026/2027 School Year

What is the weekly schedule?

Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday

September through Mid-May

We have two time slots to accommodate parents and provide ease and less congestion with drop off and pickup:

Session A: 9:00am to 12:15pm

Session B: 9:30am to 12:45pm

What age groups are available for Preschool?

Classes are available for children ages two and a half (two by February 1, 2026), three-, four-, and five-year-olds who have not started kindergarten. Children need to be of class age on or before August 1st, 2026. For example, if your child is entering the 3-year-old program, your child would need to be 3 by August 1, 2026. If your child does not turn 3 until after August 1st, 2026, they would be placed in our 2-year-old program.

Does my child have to be potty trained before starting preschool?

While it is not a requirement for our 2-year-old students and 3-year-old students to be potty trained, children entering the 4-year-old classes will need to be fully potty trained and able to handle toileting duties by themselves.

How much is tuition and enrollment cost for the 2026/2027 school year?

- **Tuition for 2- and 3-year-old programs:** \$195/month; due 1st of each month (September 1st through May 1st)
- **Tuition for 4-year-old Pre-K program:** \$220/month; due 1st of each month (September 1st through May 1st)

Enrollment: A registration fee of \$125 per school year per child; covering enrollment, classroom supplies, for school year, snacks, and the Brightwheel app fee.

Enrollment is on a first come first serve basis and is considered complete once the registration form and enrollment fee are received.

When can we enroll?

Open enrollment begins **March 1, 2026.**

How can we enroll?

You may register your child online at www.littleflock.com/preschool. Once you have filled out the online registration form, you will be contacted by a member of our staff with instructions for the next step in the registration process. If there is a spot for your

child, you will be instructed to pay the registration fee, securing a spot for your child. If no spot is available, your child will be placed on a waiting list, and you will be contacted if an opening becomes available. ***Do not send in the Registration fee until it is requested from the director. There is no guarantee that your child will have a spot if you send in the registration fee without being prompted to do so.**

Is Little Flock a certified Preschool with an official curriculum?

Although LFPS is not officially a certified preschool, it is run like one. Your child's experience is much more like preschool than daycare. Each day we focus on letters, numbers, shapes, colors, gross/fine motor skills, perceptual skills (Illustrated on the Skills Chart) while teaching the love of Christ and Biblical truths. A variety of teaching mediums will be used each day (songs, stories, crafts, worksheets, games, learning through play, etc.) to ensure your children are having fun while learning.

How does Little Flock handle music and playtime?

Weather permitting, children in all classes will be given time outside to stretch and build their muscles through activity each day (playground, walks, games). In the case of cold or inclement weather, playrooms are available as well as indoor activities designed to get the kiddos up and moving. In addition to regular class time, each child will participate in music class to learn about the true meaning of worship, rhythm, instruments, etc.

Snacks and Lunch?

Only a small snack will be provided during class time (i.e.-goldfish, apple sauce pouches, etc.) by our staff. We do try to be sensitive to children's allergies and provide a safe, nut free environment. We do have party days and celebrate holidays, so snacks will vary on those days.

Will we be getting a supply list?

While the enrollment fee covers basic school supplies (crayons, markers, scissors, etc.), you may receive a wish/supply list from your child's teacher as well as requests throughout the year for party days and such. Each child will need a full-size backpack with an extra set of clothing and possibly a folder (depending on teacher). There could be a small fee paid to your child's teacher to help with memory books and developing pictures, usually between \$8-\$15.

What are typical student to teacher class ratios?

Two-Year-Old Classes: 2 Teachers to 12 children

Three-Year-Old Classes: 2 Teachers to 16 children

Four-Year-Old Classes: 2 Teachers to 18 children

Which class will my child be placed in?

For the 2026/2027 school year the age cutoff date for children entering school is August 1st. This means your child must turn 5 years old on or before August 1st, 2026, for them to enter into kindergarten. We will follow this criteria for our preschool as well and all children will be placed in their classes according to the age group they will be entering school with. Please keep this in mind when registering your child.
